- Planning, supervision and execution of exploration field activities including diamond drilling, regional and local-scale mapping, geophysics and geochemical sampling.
- Data compilation initiatives focused on increasing integrity, standardization, resolution and completeness.
- Manage and liaise with supporting industry consultants and advisors.
- Provide technical leadership within an exploration team setting including review, development and updates in exploration policies and procedures.
- Pursue innovation and technologies for the unlocking of modernized techniques in analysis.

Preferred Qualifications and Education

- Self-starter, continuous learner, and a passion for innovation in geoscience related to mineral exploration.
