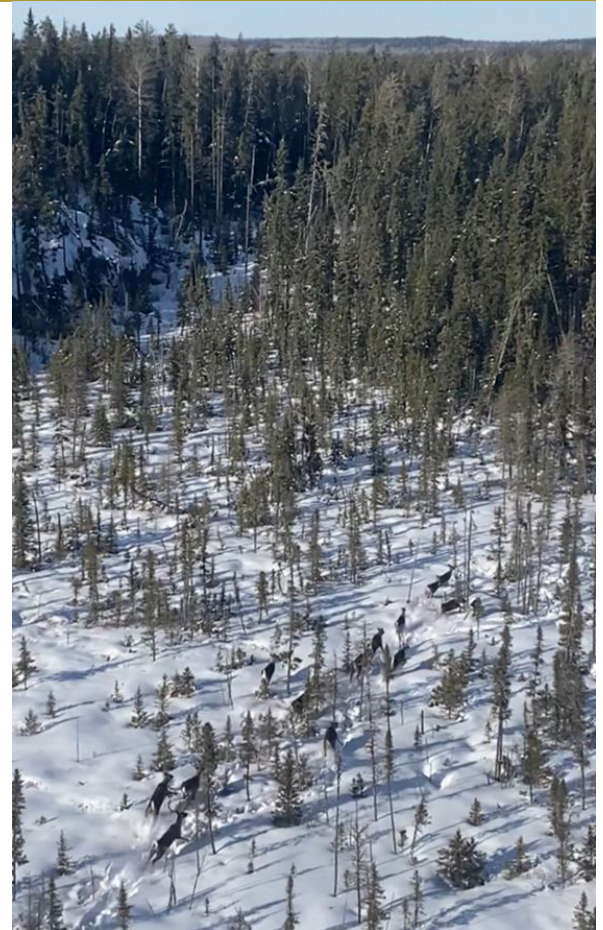

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS TIMELINE

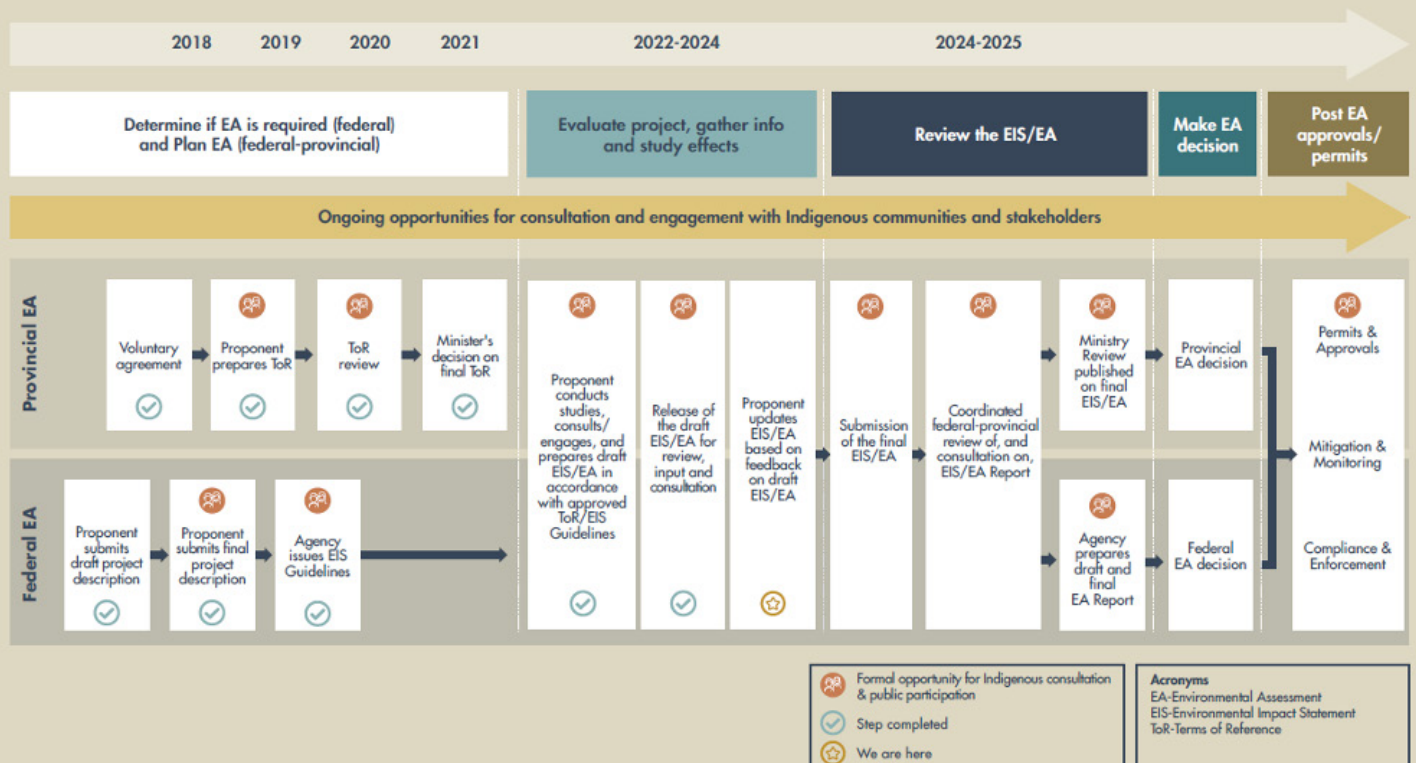
First Mining Gold has been working closely with the Federal and Provincial environmental approval agencies to coordinate the Federal and Provincial Environmental Impact Statement /Environmental Assessment/ (EIS/EA). The coordinated approach facilitates greater efficiency and fosters cooperation between parties.

First Mining Gold will be continuing consultation with local Indigenous communities and stakeholders throughout the coordinated provincial-federal environmental assessment process and takes aim at late summer 2024, as the date for the final EIS/EA submission.

CARIBOU SURVEY

In February, FMG continued with its ongoing caribou study in the regional study area around the Springpole site with a Winter Aerial Survey. The purpose of the Winter Aerial Survey was to obtain a count and distribution of caribou and classify observed caribou with respect to sex and age. The survey was conducted by helicopter equipped with VHF antennae in order to relocate caribou with satellite telemetry collars. Over 300 caribou were observed, as well as other species such as Moose.

WOLVERINE STUDY

As a part of the on-going baseline environmental studies, First Mining Gold environmental team continues to embark on our 2024 wolverine studies. 25 non-invasive stations have been established and are yielding fantastic results and even got a visit from two non-target species.

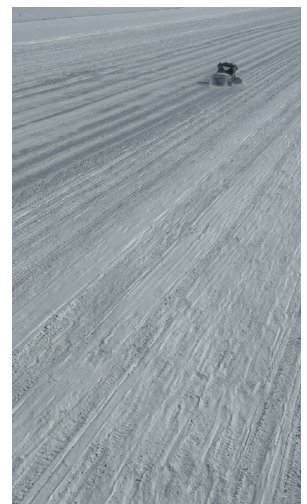
SIJHL Sioux Lookout Bomber's Awards Dinner
